

Christmas Events & Notices—

St James' Christmas Jumper Day – Traditionally we always hold our Christmas jumper day on our School dinner day which will be held next Wednesday 18th December. All children can come in Christmas jumpers and we do not ask for any money for this, it's a celebration of Christmas together as a school. Any children who usually bring a pack lunch who would like to have a school Christmas dinner, please contact the office.

Nativity Update - We still have a relatively large number of tickets available for both performances. We are proud to upheld our policy of not charging an admission fee for our Nativity performances but would love a full church to perform to. If any families or friends would like extra tickets please collect from the school office.

Please note that we can only admit people to the Nativity performances with a school ticket.

There is a funeral taking place in the church in the morning and therefore we ask parents out of respect for the family and friends, please not to arrive before 1 at the very earliest.

<u>Can all costumes for the Nativity be brought into school on Monday for the dress</u> rehearsal.

All children should be returned back to school at 4.30 p.m. on the 17th, so they have time to get changed and they will then be taken to the church for the performance at 5.

Alternatively children can remain in school between performances and should be booked into after-school club.

<u>Parent Info – No photograph policy.</u> Please may I strongly repeat the messages passed out before each and every school event that we also that all parents do not take photographs or videos the event. This policy is there to protect the safeguarding of our children. To help parents capture the event, the staff and children continually take photos and videos of events, which we then check, then upload to our school website for all parents to see.

School Disco – This will run from 4pm – 6pm on Wednesday 18th December. This disco is for all children and we also open up quieter areas for any children who struggle with the loud noise. Again we have been inundated with support from our PTA volunteers who will be helping out selling sweets, tattoos and decorative glow bracelets. Mr King has asked me to pass on his thanks for parents coming forward to help. Admission to the disco will be £2.

Toy Day – Friday 20th December. We are all looking forward to our last day and would like to celebrate with a traditional Toy Day. We ask that children don't bring in expensive, electronic games in case they are damaged or lost. We also ask all children not to bring in any devices that can acquire the internet or take photographs.
